## Conditions of Entry

1. This competition will be conducted under EFA rules.
2. Horses are limited to two consecutive levels. No horse may be entered in more than three tests.
3. **NCEC regrets that we cannot cater for riders who have more than 1 horse and wish to ride at both venues.**
4. The competition at CRC will have the normal range of prizes and ribbons will be awarded to 6th place. Catering will be available.
5. Only 1st prize will be awarded for the Medium to Grand Prix – wine and/or chocolates. Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place.
6. Due to the lack of resources there will be no catering available at Pegasus however tea and coffee will be available on an honour system.
7. Prospective riders need to note that dogs are not allowed at Pegasus.
8. Entry fees must accompany entries and may now be paid by internet banking. If you choose to use this option **the receipt MUST accompany the entry form to be accepted.** Enter the riders name and competition date as the reference, eg LPugh12Feb06. NCEC's account details are:-

9. Competitors MUST pay a \$20 levy if they are NOT a member of the EFA, NCEC or an EFA Affiliated Club. **Proof of membership with an EFA Affiliated club MUST be provided with the entry form.**
10. **Late entries** will only be accepted at the discretion of the club. **ALL late entries will incur a late fee of \$10 per test in addition to the usual fee.**
11. EFA Disclaimer Forms MUST be completed and submitted with the entry form if you are a member of the EFA, NCEC or an EFA Affiliated Club. Non-members MUST also sign a non-member waiver, which must be submitted before riding on the day. (*Member and Non-Member waivers can be obtained off the NCEC website*).
12. **No refunds will be made after the closing date for entries.** The club will refund 50% of entry fees when presented with a veterinary or medical certificate within 48 hours of the competition.
13. Grading points **MUST** be included for all events. Please ensure that for all official tests both horse or pony and rider are **current members of the EFA.**
14. Bridle numbers are compulsory for all official tests.
15. All competitors are required to wear an **AS/NZS 3838 1998** or **EN 1384** or **ASTN F1 163** helmet at all times when mounted. Failure to comply with this ruling will result in elimination.
16. Ribbons will be awarded to sixth place in all classes.
17. NCEC Inc. is not responsible for any damage, loss, illness, injury, or accident to persons, animals or equipment.
18. The organising committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any section of the program.
19. A veteran horse is a horse aged 15years and over on the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2008. Note: this NCEC member's annual award can only be won once in a horse's lifetime.
