CLOSING DATE WITH CLUB SECRETARY: Sunday 2 August 2009 (Club Secretary is to ensure entries are in the zone's P0 Box (Zone Secretary, PO Box 940 Civic Square, ACT, 2608) by 1pm Friday 7 August 2009)

GENERAL INFORMATION: All competitors must be graded to be eligible to compete. Grading cards must be produced on day of competition. ***NO CARD NO RIDE.*** The competition will be run for A, B, C, D and E grade.

Each family of a competitor must provide a helper to assist with the championship (one helper per family, no helper no ride). Championship will be run under the rules of the Pony Club Association of NSW (see blue book and PCANSW website). Riders should make themselves aware of all the rules. The Committee reserves the right to alter the program if required. The draw, jobs for helpers and jobs for clubs will be posted on the Zone 16 website <http://www.zone16.pcansw.org.au>. All Club Secretaries, riders and helpers must regularly inspect the zone 16 website for information concerning draws, update to draws and jobs.

Rosettes to 5th place in each grade/group. – Team awards to 5th place. There will be a team competition for the ***PRELL CUP TROPHY*** for Zone 16 clubs.

STATE ONE DAY EVENT NOMINATION: To be eligible and considered for State nomination rider must have attended 3 rally days in the last 12 months, meet conditions set out in Blue Book (sections 8 and 4), provide a copy of their performance card with their entry and be at the minimum grading required namely:

12 and under 15years (Novice): C grade
13 and under 15 years (Advanced): B grade
15 and under 17 years (Novice): B grade
15 and under 17years (Advanced): A grade
17 and under 25 years (Novice): A grade
17 and under 25years (Advanced): Championship grade
