SHOW INFORMATION & CATEGORY EXPLANATIONS

PLEASE NOTE STATE TITLE ENTRANTS MAY COMPETE IN TWO CONSECUTIVE DIVISIONS BUT ON DIFFERENT HORSES.

- Entries Close Friday 25th September, 2009.
- Change of entry on the day will cost \$5.00/change - this will be strictly adhered to.
- This event will be conducted under FEI/EFA Rules.
- Junior riders are riders from the year of their 12th birthday to the year of their 18th birthday
- Young Riders are riders from the year of their 16th birthday to the year of their 21st birthday.
- Senior State Title Riders must be in the year of their 18th birthday and over.
- Amateur riders are riders who have not competed in a World Cup Qualifying competition, Olympic Games, World Championship in Showjumping or Eventing or have competed at Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane or Adelaide Royal Show in the last 2 years and are 21 years of age and over. (New NSW ruling)
- FEI World Challenge classes. Riders may compete in both categories on different horses. Riders may ride more than one horse in a category. If riding more than one horse you must nominate which horse you wish to be your competitive horse at the office on the day before the competition.
- Cat. A is two classes of the Amateur State Title. The Amateur State Championship includes Class 7b and FEI Cat. A classes.
- All riders and owners of horses starting in official classes must be members of Equestrian Australia.
- All horses nominated in official classes must hold current registration and grading cards from the EA. Grading will be in accordance with the National Grading System. Note: All riders must present their grading cards to the judge at the presentation of awards or prizemoney will not be issued.
- Australian or European Helmet Standards hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted on a horse. This includes presentations and non -competition days.
- Summer Uniform will be permitted if weather conditions require. If riding without a coat proper riding shirts with long sleeves, tie or ratcatcher will be permissible. If you wish to wear a back protector you have the option of wearing a riding coat or not.

PRESENTATIONS: Riders will be expected to wear coats at the presentations.

- The Organising Committee reserves the right to, at their absolute discretion, alter or amend any of the conditions, regulations or any aspect of the event as it sees fit.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to swab horses. FEI and State Championship classes will be swabbed.
- Dogs are to be restrained at all times and are not permitted in practice areas or the main competition arenas.

REFUNDS

- 50% refund will only be given on presentation of a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate. 100% refund if notification of withdrawal is given prior to the closing date or cancellation of the show.

NO REFUNDS will be given for not competing in classes already entered.

- Only riders competing in the current competition may use the final practice area. Only six horses will be allowed in the practice area at any one time. Other warm up areas will be provided.
- To be eligible to compete all competitors must complete the Disclaimer Statement forms.
- Riders may compete in two consecutive State Championship divisions provided they meet the age requirements, but on different horses.

A \$20 stable bond will be required on acquiring your stable, stall, yard/your make your own yard area. This is refundable at the end of the show if stable/stall/yard/your make your own yard area is left clean.
