The seminar will comprise of:

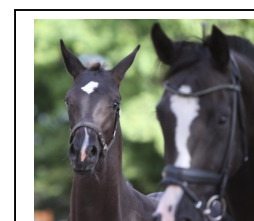
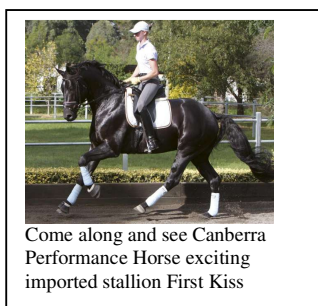
- A presentation on how to train young horses, what the basic principles are, and the pitfalls of incorrect riding and applying too much pressure too soon by Uwe Spenlen – 1200 – 1.00pm;
- A presentation by Dr Rebecca Walshe MRCVS of Canberra Equine Hospital on the physiology of the young horse and what can go wrong with young horses such as OCD, and common developmental problems -1.00 – 1.30pm;
- A demonstration on young horse handling, lunging and long reining (doppel longe) with a selection of quality young horses 2.00 – 2.30pm;
- A ridden seminar including 4, 5 and 6 year old horses with Uwe explaining the key points to look for when judging, riding and training these ages and stages of horse 2.30 - 4.30; and
- A Stallion Parade and Grand Prix Pas De Deux to Music – 4.30 to 5.00pm
