## ***BENDICK MURRELL SPORTSGROUND***

- The Bendick Murrell Sports ground is situated about 25 minutes north of Young, and 35 minutes south of Cowra, on the Olympic Way. It is a quiet, picturesque setting, with plenty of shade and parking.
- There is plenty of warm up area and the ground is mostly a sandy loam. Currently we have five sand competition arenas and a large sand warm-up area.
- **Travelling times (towing):** Approximately 2 hours from Canberra, 2 hours from Wagga, 2 hours from Orange and 4 hours from Richmond.
- **STABLING – ALL STABLING INQUIRIES to Stable Co-ordinator: Julie Vandyke 0263414 010 or 0429 414010.** Stable/yard booking includes Straw Bedding. All bedding must be removed prior to departure or you can choose to pay a cleaning fee of \$20/stable or yard.
- **Stables:** 16 only rubberlined stables are on the ground – preference given to the furthest travelling competitors and FEI. If we are unable to provide a stable and you do not want to accept a steel yard for your horse, you will need to make your own stabling arrangements. Stabling also available at the Young Showground (20 minutes away), secretary – Mrs Pat Fletcher 63822079 for details and bookings. Alternatively – Cowra Showground 63421977.
- **Yards:** Good quality steel yards will be erected – pre-booking required, plenty available. There are also approximately 12 timber railed yards, mostly under shady gum trees which you are welcome to use at your own risk. These are NOT booked out, so first in, first served. Under **EA** rules, electric fence yards are not permitted.

## Young Dressage Assoc Inc Events – Conditions of Entry 2011

Events will be held in accordance with current EFA Dressage Rules as amended except where FEI Rules apply. The YDA Inc committee may grant exemptions to the rules for special promotional competitions. **The onus is on competitors to know the rules.** The conditions below are relevant for competitions held by YDA Inc.

1. **Official & Associate** competitions: Refer current 2011 EA Dressage Rule Book.
2. **Preparatory Tests** – open to horses who haven't won more than 3 preparatory tests, or who haven't placed at Novice level or above.
3. **Horses/ponies:** All competitions (unless otherwise stated) are open to horses or ponies. Please indicate on the entry form if your horse is a pony. Official classes only will be judged separately.
4. **Height of horses and ponies:** Refer current 2011EA Dressage Rules.
5. **Stallions;** Effective as of 01 January 2011, The horse (stallion) & Float display Stallion Identification Discs at all times. Discs are available for purchase from the National Office of equestrian Australia. Stallions are to be handled as in EA guidelines
6. **CLASSES limited** to 35 horses/ponies only – In the event of oversubscription there will be a RESERVE list. Horses will be accepted in order of receipt of entry. You will be given the option to transfer to another competition if you are on the reserve list.
7. Riders may be changed before the start of competition; however, a rider of a horse may not be changed if another rider has ridden the horse on the day, either in warm-up or in a competition. Draw position cannot be changed without the permission of the Organising Committee. One rider per horse for the whole event.
8. A competitor may not add a horse to the draw without approval of the OC
9. No more than 3 tests per horse can be ridden on one day and no more than 2 consecutive levels.
10. Horses cannot compete below their graded level unless they compete NC/HC (non competitively)
11. **Hors Concours** (Non competitive): Riders wishing to ride HC/NC must declare their intention **in writing** before the start of the competition (test).
12. **Riders** will not be permitted to ride if entry fees have not been received by the Organising Committee.
13. **Bridle & EA numbers must be submitted on entry form.** If awaiting issue of either please indicate on entry form. **Bridle numbers (2) are compulsory in all tests**, one on either side of the horse, they must be clearly displayed so that the judge can identify the rider when riding in front of the judges vehicle. Horses are not required to stop at the judge's car- rider must ensure that judge has seen and acknowledged them
14. **Scratchings** will be accepted up to the closing date. **Refunds** as per EA rules. The compulsory Admin fee is not refundable.
15. **DNAs** please show the courtesy of scratching before the day if you are unable to attend the event.
16. **Callers** are allowed
17. **Random swabbing** may take place. If approached by Official Steward / Vet Officer of the day, competitors must allow samples to be taken from their horse for drug tests.
18. **EA Registration** and performance cards must be available on the day of competition (official events).
19. **Please** use the YDA Entry Form to enter YDA events.
20. **Gear Check** – all competitors must present to the Gear Steward. Failure to do so may incur elimination.
21. **Warm-up** please use designated warm-up areas, be aware of group riding rules, look where you are going, keep at least 10m from competition arenas.
22. **Conditions for Riding Attire & Hats.** As per EA Rules or special conditions as covered in the Competition schedule. Riders under 18 must wear an approved safety helmet at all times. Riders training other than warming up for a test must wear an approved safety helmet at all times.
23. **Dogs** must be on a leash at all times. Dogs, children, prams etc are not allowed in the competition area.
24. **Stabling:** overnight stabling is available Contact the event organizer for further information.  
**No temporary** yards/fences made substantially of electrical fencing/rope or similar material is to be used to construct yards.
25. **Camping** is available at events please contact the event organizer for information.
26. **Video Cameras** and equipment must be kept at least 10 metres from the arena, preferably at C or A end of arena.
27. All competitors must abide by current regulations as set down by the **NSW DPI** in respect to traveling and horse events.
28. Only horses that are entered for a competition are permitted on the grounds during the event.
29. **PRIZEMONEY FOR FEI COMPETITIONS** – Total advertised prizemoney may not be awarded if there are **LESS THAN 4** competitors in each class.
30. **AWARDS: MEMBERS PERFORMANCE;**  
**Perpetual Trophy**, donated by Jenny Bryant – highest aggregate percentage of two tests Medium Level and/or above. Must be financial members of YDA.  
**LIREMBENDA TROPHY** for Junior riders (17 years and under) - for the highest aggregate percentage in the Junior competitions.  
**SIMPENDORFER TROPHY** – For most successful club member over 40 years of age.  
**COOLINDA PARK ARABIAN AWARD** for highest % Arabian or derivative.
31. **CHAMPIONS: Awarded as per EA rules for all Official (open) classes. . Associate champion awards will only be for Preliminary and Novice levels. There will be a FEI Small Tour Champion and FEI Big tour champion. Pony Champions will be awarded for Prelim- Novice Pony Champion and Elementary & Above Pony Champion. For Pony classes the Champion will be the highest aggregate percentage of the two tests ridden at one level**
32. The YDA organising committee reserves the right to exercise these conditions of entry.

### Welfare of the horse is paramount.

1. Refer to current EA Dressage competition rules.
