GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Please read carefully

The Committee reserves the right to accept or reject entries without assigning a reason. Entries are accepted on the condition that exhibitors will agree and abide by the Show Rules and rules for the use of the Sydney International Equestrian Centre.

FEES PAYABLE

ALL FEES MUST BE PAID AT TIME OF ENTRY

PAYMENT OF FEES

Any cheque or money order received or accepted by the Committee shall be deemed to have been received as a conditional payment only and subject to payment upon presentation. Exhibitors should keep records of all Entries and payments sent through the mail in case of same going astray.

REFUNDS

No refunds will be made under any circumstances after the advertised "closing date of entry". Please ensure you read the Judging Timetable on Page 3 so that you are aware of the days your classes will be Judged.

AGE OF ALL PONIES

To be calculated as from 1st August.

COPIES OF REGISTRATIONS & PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP

Copies of all registrations & memberships must be forwarded with your entries. Pending registrations and memberships will NOT be accepted under any circumstances.

EXHIBIT NUMBERS & CATALOGUE

A catalogue will be supplied to each exhibitor along with exhibit numbers. No substitution of entries will be permitted after the advertised "closing date of entry".

Exhibit numbers may be worn on either the Handler, Rider or the Horse.

ONE HANDLER/RIDER RULE

Handlers/Riders may only show 1 pony in ANY class and changing of handlers or riders during a class is prohibited. Classes will NOT be held for handlers or riders with the exception of Championships and Finals. A rider may only ride one pony in a Final.

ALL EXHIBITORS

If the Chief Steward in any ring, in his/her opinion finds that the behaviour of any exhibitor is offensive or disruptive in any way to any other competitor or to the judge, that exhibitor may be eliminated from the event.

SUBSTITUTION OF EXHIBITS

There will be no substitution of Exhibits after the "advertised" closing date of entry.

ENTRANT NAMES

ALL ponies must be entered under their registered name and in the name of the registered owner as appears on the pony's registration papers.

Each entry that is made in a different exhibitor name must be treated as a "separate entry" and the appropriate fees paid (eg. cataloguing and Administration).

THE COMMITTEE ACCEPT NO RESPONSIBILITY

It is the policy of the Committee to see that all due care is taken to protect property, but the Committee shall not be liable to any person in the case of loss or damage by reason of any defect, accident, negligence or neglect however arising.

IDENTIFICATION OF EXHIBITS

Each exhibit must be able to be identified if requested by a Committee Member by checking microchips, brands and/or markings against it's supplied registration certificate/s. Unless otherwise directed, each handler must display the correct number for the relevant exhibit during each of it's events.

GELDINGS

Ponies entered in Gelding classes must be gelded and registered as geldings.

BROODMARES

A Broodmare must be visibly in foal, have a foal at foot or must have had a foal registered with a relevant Society within the last 3yrs. Broodmares are not eligible for any ridden class.

JUDGES

Judges for the various sections are correct at the time of printing. However, it should be realised that situations can change. Therefore, if a judge whose name appears in this schedule cannot meet their commitment, the Committee reserves the right to substitute a Judge and will make all efforts advertise the change through various reasonable outlets.

Refund of entries will not be applied in this situation unless a proven & written conflict of interest will occur between the substituted judge and an exhibitor. Please be advised that should this situation arise, the Committee may contact all parties involved should they see fit.

PROTEST

- Any Exhibitor who desires to enter a protest concerning any decision on the part of a Judge or any decision or act or omission on the part of the Societies responsible for this event or any Official, shall lodge a protest form (available from the Secretary's Office) before noon on the day next following the day on which such decision, act or omission occurred.
- Every protest must be accompanied by a fee of \$100.00 Cash and this amount will be forfeited if the protest is NOT upheld.
- The protest shall be determined by a panel of 3 Show Committee Members. The final decision shall be final and binding. No reasons for the final outcome shall be required.

ASSEMBLY IN MARSHALLING AREA

Exhibitors must have their horses in the Marshalling Area not later than 10 minutes prior to the timetabled start time of the event. Any Exhibitor NOT present with his or her horse at the time of the commencement of the event will not be permitted to compete in such event except at the discretion of the Ringmaster OR Marshalling Steward. No refund of the entry fee will be given.

MEASURING

Measuring of all exhibits is not compulsory and EFA, SHC or Royal Show measuring certificates for the current year will be accepted should the height of a pony be queried OR if a protest is lodged.

BROODMARES

A Broodmare must have a foal at foot OR be in foal and due in the current breeding season

CRUELTY TO HORSES

No Exhibitor shall engage or be knowingly involved in cruelty to a horse. The Show Committee shall be the sole Judge of what constitutes cruelty, but it may include:

- to whip or beat a horse excessively
- to subject the horse to any kind of electric shock
- to use spurs, or to jab the horse in the mouth with the bit, excessively or persistently
- to remount, or attempt to remount, an exhausted, lame or injured horse
- to rap a horse
- to hypersensitise any part of a horse
- to leave a horse without adequate food or drinking water

Any case of cruelty must be reported to the Show Committee Chairman, Head Stable Warden or Ringmaster immediately.

PRIZE RIBBONS

Place Ribbons will be awarded to 5th Place.

PRIZE MONEY

Payment for ALL Prize money will be sent to the Exhibitor after the show. The cheque/s will be made out to the Exhibitor as listed in the catalogue and posted to the address listed on the Entry Form.

ACCEPTABLE ATTIRE

For all Attendants in LED Classes:

- Long trousers/skirts
- Long or 3/4 sleeved shirt or blouse with collar
- Tie, Stock or cravat for men
- Waist coat and/or coat
- Hat (not baseball type)
- Enclosed shoes or boots

For all Riders

- Approved Headwear MUST be worn when mounted at ALL times
- Breeches or Jodhpurs (light coloured)
- Fully enclosed boots
- Riding Jacket
- Tie or Stock

- All venue signage must be adhered to at all times.
- People and horses are to utilise pathways and roadways at all times. KEEP OFF THE GRASS.
- Vehicles, persons or animals are allowed no access into Woodland area at any time.
- Clean up and deposit any manure in the bins allocated.
- NO Smoking at or within the stable area.
- Vehicles are to be parked in designated areas ONLY
- Camping is only allowed in the designated camping areas.
- NO fires are to be lit under any circumstances.
- NO excessive noise to be made at night.
- Leave site in a clean condition.
- NO vehicles or horses may enter the Cross Country paths/areas.

SAFETY HELMETS

Approved safety helmets must be worn at all times whilst mounted on either a bike or horse.

STABLE BOOKINGS, ALLOCATION & FEES

Stabling is to be booked at the time of entry. NO bedding will be provided unless paid for with your entries. Pre-ordered shavings will be placed in your stables unopened prior to your arrival.

STABLE CLEANING

ALL bedding is to be removed from stables after use and placed in the bins provided or taken with you. Failure to clean your stables will result in payment of your stable bond.

ACCOMMODATION CABINS

A limited number of cabins are available. Each has 2 single beds (bedding not supplied), Exhibitors travelling from Interstate or from a long distance will be given priority.

CAMPING SITES

Powered Camp sites are available and must be booked and paid when you enter.
