TIMETABLE:

Exhibitors please note – programs will commence from 8.30am both days and all events will follow in order listed. Please note program and enter the Judging Ring of the class in which you are entered in, on time when called. The committee reserves the right to alter or delete events without prior note. The organizers take no responsibility where events clash or are late. **CLASSES WILL NOT BE DELAYED.**

ENTRIES:

Available at the Ticket Office (Caravan)

Ribbons: 1st, 2nd and 3rd

Entry fee per class will be \$2 unless otherwise stipulated. All entries to be taken on the day of competition. No entry fee refunded. All prize money to be collected on the day of show.

ID entry tickets must be obtained from Ticket Office, filled in and handed to the ring steward in charge of ring on entry of each event. An exhibitors, their agent or agents, must prove the correctness of any entry if and when called upon by the stewards.

All competitors must sign indemnity & waiver book at ticket office, before receiving entry tickets.

The Adele Smith Memorial Supreme Ridden Hack, Galloway or Pony of the Show will again be a feature of Sunday's events, attracting \$100 in prize money, a trophy and a perpetual trophy.

GENERAL CONDITIONS - COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE

1. The registration certificate, when applicable, must be present when the entry is made.
2. All persons together with animals and vehicles enter the show grounds at their own risk.
3. All protests must be in writing and must be lodged with the secretary, within thirty (30) minutes of the alleged violation of the rules have occurred, with a deposit of \$50, the deposit will be forfeited if the protest is dismissed.
4. Any exhibitor who refuses to co-operate with any reasonable direction given by a committee member, Steward or Show Official, may be ineligible to compete.
5. The decision of the Judge will, at all times is final.
6. All horses must at all times be under proper control and supervision.
7. The Committee reserves the right to appoint any judge to any ring at any time.
8. A judge has the right to dismiss any competitor from the ring in which he or she is judging at any time.
9. A judge has the right to refuse to award a 1st or any prize.
10. All competitors **MUST** wear approved helmets, applicable to the event in which they are competing, a tie, suitable footwear and clothing in the judging ring.

ACCIDENT AND PUBLIC RISK INSURANCE:

Any accident which may occur during any horse show or any function conducted by the Society must be reported to the Secretary in writing and verified by writing during the currency of the show, if these conditions are not adhered to, the Society will accept no responsibility for the consideration of any claim.

DEFINITIONS:

LOCAL: The term "LOCAL" shall apply to horses and riders whose principal place of residence is within the Goulburn Mulwaree Council area.

BROODMARE: Is a mare, which has had a foal, registered with a relevant society within the last 3 years, or for which a pregnancy test certificate has been supplied with the entry, or has a foal at foot, and is eligible to compete in Brood Mare, Groups or Double Registered Classes only.

SENIOR: Means have attained a 17th Birthday prior to the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR: Means not having attained a 17th Birthday prior to the first day of the Show.

(The age of the person is determined as at the day of the show).

NOVICE: A Novice Hack, Hunter or Rider is one who has never placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an individual open event at any Agricultural Show.

INTERMEDIATE: An Intermediate Hack, Hunter or Rider is one who has never placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an individual open event at a 'Horse of The Year' show, or a 'Royal Show' including Bathurst and Toowoomba.

CONSOLATION EVENTS: Are for horses and riders who have not won a prize in similar events at this show on the day of competition.

PONY: ne. 14 hh

GALLOWAY: 14 hands & ne. 15 hh

HACK: 15hh & over

ne. Means not exceeding

REGULATIONS:

STALLIONS AND COLTS

- ❖ Stallions & Colts may only compete in classes where specifically permitted.
- ❖ Riders of colts and stallion, whilst on the grounds, or competing must be 17 years of age and over.
- ❖ All colts and stallions, 2 years of age and over, must be bitted.
- ❖ The ringmaster may at any time require a person who does not appear to be able to handle any horse or pony to dismount, allows another person to handle the horse/pony, or leave the ring.

BROOD MARES

- ❖ Brood Mares are NOT eligible to compete in classes other than those provided for them. They may compete in group or double registered classes.

SHOW HUNTER CLASSES

- ❖ For animals that have substance that would normally be acceptable in modern ridden show classes. These animals must still be quality animals, with priorities being type, confirmation, action and temperament.
- ❖ Judging is carried out as per the Hack classes but the ponies or horses may have been asked to work at a pace.
- ❖ Ponies and horses must be three years and over.
- ❖ Ridden show hunter ponies over 12.2 hh and ne. 14hh may be ridden by Adults or Children.

AGE OF HORSE/PONIES

- ❖ The age of the horse is calculated as from the 1st of August. Every horse/pony foaled before the 1st August in any year is deemed to be one year older on that date.

RESTRAINING BITS

- ❖ All stallions and colts two years old and over must be in the charge of a competent handler, and must be properly controlled with a suitable restraining bit in their mouth in use and wearing head gear of proper strength and quality, which is in use.
- ❖ A suitable restraining bit or a show halter (which must have a throat halter) is acceptable on mares and fillies.

EQUIPMENT

- ❖ Whips in ridden classes shall not exceed 77cm in total length. Except in Show Jumping where EFA regulations will be enforced. The length includes the flap.
- ❖ Spurs, which are capable of wounding a horse, are forbidden. There must be a shank not exceeding 4cm in length pointing only towards the rear.

ADULT (SENIOR) RIDING CLASSES

- ❖ Ponies must not be ridden in Senior Riding Classes. Horses only over 14hh only may be ridden in Senior Riding Classes.

CHILDRENS' (JUNIOR) RIDING CLASSES

- ❖ All children in Children's riding classes must be suitable mounted, the judge's decision in this respect is final.
- ❖ Except for classes restricted to riders aged 6 years and under 9years, parents or assistants will not be permitted in the ring during judging of children's riding classes.
- ❖ Should any parent or assistant impart any tuition whatsoever or encouragement to a child rider during the course of judging, the child rider shall be immediately disqualified.
- ❖ Riders in Pony Hack classes under 12.2hh must be less than 17 years of age, unless, dispensation from President, Ring Master & Chief Steward is obtained.
- ❖ All children riders must wear a safety helmet.

RINGMASTER

- ❖ The word Ringmaster includes, the Ringmaster, any deputy or assistant ringmaster and any person for the time being exercising some or all of the functions of a ringmaster.

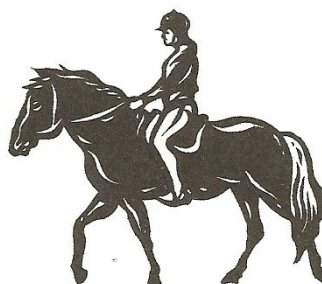

RULES FOR THE PRYDE'S EASIFEED SUPREME CHAMPION HACK OF ZONE 3

1. The only eligible Horse for this Event is Champion Ridden Hack of Show, Champion Ridden Galloway Hack of Show or Champion Ridden Pony Hack of Show.
2. **SHOW HUNTER CLASSES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.**
3. If there is a change of ownership the Horse is still eligible for entry into this event.
4. No substitute Horse is permissible in this event.
5. In the event that there is a draw in any event eligible for the Pryde's EasiFeed Champion Hack, Champion Galloway Hack or Champion Pony Hack of Zone 3 both Horses are eligible to enter.
6. First Prize will be given in the form of a voucher to be redeemable at the winner's convenience.
7. Ribbons and Prizes will be presented to Horses from 1st to 6th placing's.
8. The Pryde's Supreme Champion Hack of Zone 3 Final will always be held at Queanbeyan Show.
9. If for any reason the Supreme Champion Hack of Zone 3 event is unable to be held at the Queanbeyan Show, the Queanbeyan Show Society Inc. Horse Committee can nominate another venue and date.
10. The Judge's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. Any Competitor who desires to enter a protest against any decision, act or omission on the part of the Society, or any Official of the Society shall lodge a protest in writing within (1) one hour of event upon which the decision, act or omission occurred. The protest shall set out in detail the circumstance relied upon such Competitor, and shall be given to the Ring Secretary, accompanied by a fee of \$100, which shall be forfeited to the Society should the protest be deemed frivolous.

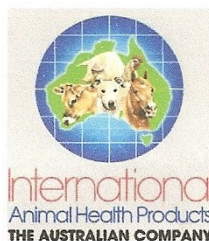
