Conditions of Entry

(All riders competing at this event are expected to have read and accepted these conditions.)

- All riders must be members of The NSW Showjumping Council Inc (Interstate riders exempt).
- All riders and owners must be current members of the Equestrian Federation of Australia.
- All horses nominated must hold current registration and showjumping grading cards from the EFA.
- Grading shall be in accordance with the National Grading System.
- The Event will be run under FEI/EFA rules.
- Australian, European & American helmets standards will apply.
- All riders must wear riding boots and an approved helmet at all times whilst mounted, including presentations.
- Coats must be worn in all presentations in the Olympic Arena.
- Coats must be worn until the organising committee say otherwise. If summer uniform is to be worn shirts must have sleeves. Ties and ratcatchers must be worn. White ties must be worn if the rider is not wearing a coat.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right at their absolute discretion to alter or amend any of the conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit.
- The Organising committee reserves the right to swab horses. Random swabbing of horses may be conducted in any class. Horses chosen for swabbing must proceed directly to the swabbing box immediately after the presentation.
- All prize presentations will be mounted. Ribbons and rugs will be placed on the horses prior to them entering the arena for the presentation. Grading cards are required to be brought to the presentation for the first 3 placegetters. Cards must be sighted by the judge or judges assistant to be able to receive prizemoney.
- Riders with stallions that are placed in a class may substitute the stallion with another horse for the presentation.
- All entries for the Wentworth Saddles Future Stars Classic must include a photocopy of the current performance card.
- Refunds: 50% refunds will be given on presentation of a doctor's certificate or a veterinary certificate. There will be no refunds for missing classes.
- If the show or any day of the show has to be cancelled entry fees will be refunded for the days cancelled.
- The \$7 Venue levy per horse per day for horses not stabled is a fee taken by SIEC.
- All dogs must be on leads and secured at all times. No dogs are allowed in the practice arenas or competition arenas.
- All prizemoney and entry fees are inclusive of GST.
- Only horses already entered in the show can enter other classes on the day with a 50% surcharge.
- All riders must report to the office for an armband before they can compete. No exceptions.

STABLING

- ARRIVAL TIME: Strictly NO arrivals permitted prior to 7am Thursday 11th December, 2008.
- Stables will be allocated and the stable area is under the direction of the stable manager.
- STABLE MANAGERS HOURS are 7am until 6pm. Prior arrangements need to be made with Mike O'Callaghan on 0404 045690 for arrivals and departures outside these times.

DEFINITIONS

- **Young Rider** – From the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 21. Riders of the correct age may compete in both Junior and Young Rider but on different horses. Horses may only compete in either Junior or Young Rider not both.
- **Junior** – From the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18. Riders of the correct age may compete in both Junior and Young Rider but on different horses. Horses may only compete in either Junior or Young Rider not both.
- **Amateur** – Is a rider 21 years and over who has not competed in a World Cup Qualifier in the past 5 years.

OLYMPIC ARENA

- The organising Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry if it is deemed unsuitable or unsportsmanlike for that class.
- Formal dress code shall apply unless otherwise advised. (White or fawn breeches only.) Shirts must have sleeves.
- The Mini-Prix class is for non World Cup horses.
- The Super Junior Final and the Young Rider Final are restricted to the top 20 qualifiers for each class from the classes listed in the schedule as Qualifying Classes.
- Points will be awarded in each qualifying class (from 1st to 10th) in each qualifying class. If there is equality of placing then the points will be shared.
- Should there be equality of points at the completion of the two qualifying classes then the rider placed highest in the second qualifying class for their division shall be ranked the highest.
- Entries for the Super Junior Final and the Young Rider Final shall be made at the show office on the Saturday afternoon by 3 pm, 13th December, without a late entry surcharge.
- Horses not qualifying for the second round of the Future Stars will be permitted to enter Class 5 (1.25m) without any charge. Entries must be made before 4pm on Friday afternoon.

ARENA TWO

- Formal dress code shall apply unless otherwise advised. (White or fawn breeches only.) Shirts must have sleeves.

WENTWORTH SADDLES FUTURE STARS CLASSIC

- Horses must be 50 points or less as of the closing date for entries, 1st December, 2008.
- Following the completion of the first round (Friday) a decision will be made as to how many competitors will start in the second round (Saturday)

WORLD CUP COMPETITORS.

- All horses entered in the World Cup Qualifying Round will be required to undergo a fitness inspection "trot-up".
- The fitness inspection will take place on Saturday 13th December. (Riders will be advised of the time and exact location.)

WELFARE OF THE HORSE – CODE OF CONDUCT

1. In all equestrian sports the horse must be considered paramount.
2. The well being of the horse shall be taken above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organisers, sponsors or officials.
3. All handling and veterinary treatment must ensure the health and welfare of the horse.
4. The highest standards of nutrition, health, sanitation and safety shall be encouraged and maintained at all times.
5. Adequate provision must be made for ventilation, feeding, watering and maintaining a healthy environment during transportation.
6. Emphasis should be placed on increasing education in training and equestrian practices and on promoting scientific studies in equine health.
7. In the interests of the horse, the fitness and competence of the rider shall be regarded as essential.
8. All riding and training methods must take account of the horse as a living entity and must not include any technique considered by the FEI to be abusive.
9. National Federations should establish adequate controls in order that all persons and bodies under their jurisdiction respect the welfare of the horse.
10. The national and international Rules and Regulations in equestrian sport regarding the health and welfare of the horse must be adhered to not only during the national and international events, but also in the training. Competition Rules and Regulations shall be continually reviewed to ensure such welfare.

3. Agrees to only move horses subject to the proper authority to do so;
4. Agrees to regularly check the DPI website for up to date information about horse movements;
5. Warrants that their horse/s are fit and well and in condition to be able to participate; and
6. Agrees to adhere to the directions of the Organising Committee whilst at the venue including but not limited to the need to quarantine or change travel or stabling arrangements.

I declare that the horse/s entered in the Event have been in good health, eating normally and has not shown signs of respiratory disease prior to entering the Event. I hereby give my authorisation for the designated Event Horse Official to call for a Veterinary inspection of horse/s in my care, should they be showing signs of a respiratory illness at any time during the course of the Event.
